Following a recent visit to the school, at the invitation of the Headteacher, Jeannette Davies and Jane Mansfield, chair of governors, I thought it was important to inform you of representations I have made on the school's behalf.

I personally raised the issue of the unsatisfactory building for pupils and staff with the Director of Education at the London Borough of Hounslow, Bob Garnett, and also on Friday with the Secretary of State for Education, the Rt Hon Ruth Kelly MP and her officials at the Department for Education and Skills. The discussions I had with all parties was very encouraging and all expressed support for the new building programme.

Today the Chancellor, of the Exchequer, the Rt Hon Gordon Brown MP, announced in his Budget in the House of Commons that primary schools are to receive priority attention and will be rebuilt or refurbished to provide additional facilities such as parent centres and ICT suites.

As Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Chancellor, it is my role to assist him in the preparation of the Budget proposals therefore; I was particularly pleased with the paragraphs relating to primary school investment.
